Plastic Bottles	Wash, clean & dry
Mix Plastics	Tie in a plastic bag

Closed Circuit TV (CCTV) Cameras

Cameras or no cameras, please also remember that all of us could also act as 'moving cameras' in that we could help to keep a vigilant look out for each other at all times and we should also volunteer to provide information to the authorities if we have witnessed a crime being committed. Only then could our "Neighborhood Watch" program be really successful and effective.
